CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Check-in time is 4:00 p.m. and check-out is noon. The Hotel's policy requires a credit card imprint upon check-in. If the guest does not have a credit card, and the Group does not guarantee the guest's room expenses, all room and tax will be collected at time of check-in along with appropriate deposits. Any unused deposit will be refunded.

If you anticipate a large number of early arrivals, or if attendees are in meetings past noon on checkout day, arrangements for an appropriate baggage hold can be made upon request.

METHOD OF RESERVATIONS/CUT-OFF DATES

It is the Hotels' understanding that all reservations will be made by an Individual call in. With this in mind, all reservation requests must be made on or before 7:00 AM, September 18, 2009. After that date, reservations will be accepted on a rate and space available basis.

Additionally, the above mentioned guestrooms occupied only qualify if they are part of the overall group block. Room reservations made with the Hotel that are not identified with the Group will not be added back to the block afterwards to be counted.

Africa In Texas



For the past forty years people have been calling the Y.O. Ranch "Africa In Texas" (circle r) because Charles Schreiner III started his exotic wildlife conservation program in the 1960s when the San Antonio Zoo's Director Fred Stark needed help with the Zoo's exotic wildlife program. The first exotic species were set free on the Ranch as an experiment in adaptation. They were Blackbuck Antelope from West Pakistan and Auodad Sheep from North Africa. Soon species like Corsican Ram from the uplands of Corsica and Sardinia and Axis deer from India followed.

Today you will see up to fifty species of exotic wildlife roaming the ranch, including Giraffes, South American Rhea, African Wildebeest and more.

So come out to the Y.O. Ranch and take one of our daily tours. Our guides will get you as close as these animals will allow which opens up opportunities for some great photos.

Our tours leave daily at 10 a.m. and last for 1 ½ to 2 hours. Lunch follows at our Chuckwagon. Reservations are required so please call ahead.

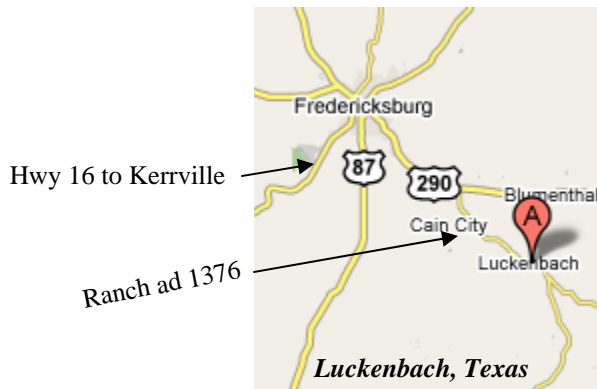
